### **EXHIBITION TITLE: Bias**

### **EXHIBITION THEME**

What role does fashion play in your life? Most likely, a larger role than you realize. Fashion is a river running through the landscape of human experience. It defines future eras and responds to current societal trends. Fashion is embedded with commentary on our culture. It is a window into people's desires and a harbinger of things to come.

Following World War II we saw the iconic full flared skirts of the 50's, a reaction to the rationing of fabrics during the war. In the 80's, we saw the exaggeration of the shoulders with shoulder pads in womenswear, as women climbed the professional ladders of the business world. Today, we see other societal trends like overproduction and literally tons of clothing filling our landfills every year.

Think about how fashion impacts you and our society. How will you explore this through your medium?

## **SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

The Hamilton Arts Collective reserves the right to decline all submissions and to cancel this request for proposals or any pre-qualified pool, at any time.

A complete application must include the following in ONE single WORD file, ONE PDF or ONE compressed ZIP file (which may include several files) on a DVD or CD or emailed to submit@hamiltonarts.org:

- 1 A one page Installation Statement. Please describe the installation concept and/or theme. Include a sketch (or sketches) of the installation.
- 2 Artist's Résumé, four pages maximum. (Teams must submit one résumé per team member.) Artist's Résumé should include all contact information (name, address, phone, email address).
- 3 5-10 proposal images. Images should be representative of the work you intend to exhibit. Images should be in JPG format 72 DPI, no larger than  $10'' \times 14''$  and no smaller than  $8'' \times 10''$ , and 1 MG or smaller.
- 4 Annotated Image List. Include the image number, artist name, artwork title, dimensions, media, year of completion, and a brief description.
- Entry fee of \$15, non-refundable (non-HAC members) or \$30 HAC Annual Membership fee. There is no entry fee for current HAC/Hamilton Gallery Members.
